

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2010 -

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTION 2-118  
OF THE CHAMPAIGN MUNICIPAL CODE, 1985, AS AMENDED  
(City Manager – Authority to Designate  
Freedom of Information Act Officers – Open Meetings Act)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN,  
ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1.** That Section 2-118 entitled “Authority to adopt Freedom of Information Act procedures”, of the Champaign Municipal Code, 1985, is hereby amended to be renamed and read as follows:

**“Sec. 2-118. Authority to designate Freedom of Information Act Officers and adopt Freedom of Information Act procedures and Authority to designate persons under the Open Meetings Act**

(a) The City Manager shall designate one or more Freedom of Information Act Officers for the City and each public body of the City. The City Manager shall adopt procedures to implement the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.) and amend such procedures from time to time as necessary. Within fourteen (14) days after the designation of Freedom of Information Act Officers or the adoption or revision of policies adopted by the City Manager under this section, such designations or policies shall be forwarded to the City Council.

(b) The City Manager shall designate one or more persons to receive required training under the Open Meetings Act for the City and each public body of the City. Within fourteen (14) days after the designation of persons under the Open Meetings Act, such designations or policies shall be forwarded to the City Council.”

**Section 2.** That this ordinance shall be effective immediately, it being determined by the Council that it is urgent that this ordinance take effect at the earliest possible date.

**Section 3.** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance immediately after passage.

**Section 4.** If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, or the provisions of the Code.
